CLEAN WATER STORY



For generations, most villagers in rural Uganda have lived with an unrelenting hardship: access to clean water. The only available water source is often a stagnant pond shared with animals, its murky depths teeming with unseen dangers causing waterborne diseases.

A chore mostly undertaken by women, fetching water means walking nearly five miles every day under the scorching sun. Balancing heavy jerrycans on their heads, they endure the painful journey to collect water from stagnant ponds. Despite the risks of disease, they have no other choice.

EATBETA's efforts have transformed the lives of several villages in rural Uganda by constructing water wells. For the first time, many villagers have access to clean water. What was once a distant dream is now reality.

When the water wells are completed, villagers often watch in awe as fresh, crystal-clear water gushes from a faucet or pipe. For the women, the days of perilous journeys are over, and they no longer have to scoop water from disease-infested ponds shared with village animals.

EATBETA is increasingly focused on constructing water wells that use an electric pump to draw water into a tank, allowing villagers to simply turn on a faucet to access clean water. Unlike a traditional water well with a hand-pump, which costs roughly \$2,500-\$3,000 to construct, a water well with an electric-pump costs around \$3,500-\$4,000. This advancement enables villagers to obtain clean water effortlessly.

Life for the villagers transforms overnight when a water well is completed. Women no longer lose hours of their day fetching water, and households are freed from sicknesses caused by contaminated water sources.

EATBETA has given them more than just water, it has given them hope, health, and a future. Villagers stand by the well, watching the water flow freely, many whisper a prayer of thanks, knowing that the burden they once carried has been washed away by the kindness of those who cared.

Many thanks go to those individuals and organizations who have donated water wells to villagers in rural Uganda, enabling EATBETA to pursue its mission of transforming and empowering rural lives.
